

# DIRECTIONS TO TYPO STATION

1334 Rose River Road, CHESHUNT VIC 3678

## From MELBOURNE:

### Via SEYMOUR (HUME HIGHWAY)

Enter the M31 **Hume Highway**, northbound

Approximately 35km after passing the BENALLA off ramps, take the MILAWA GOURMET REGION exit

Turn RIGHT at the T-intersection at the end of the off ramp onto the **Glenrowan-Myrtleford Road (C522)**

A T-intersection will appear after approximately 9km - turn RIGHT onto the **Wangaratta-Whitfield Road (C521)**

Travel along this road for approximately 44km to CHESHUNT, passing through DOCKER, MOYHU, EDI, KING VALLEY & WHITFIELD (the road becomes **King Valley Road** after WHITFIELD)

Continue on this road through CHESHUNT (the road now becomes the **Rose River Road**)

After approximately 5km the **Rose River Road** becomes unsealed - drive carefully! The road is winding and the surface may be in quite rough or loose. At night, wombats, kangaroos and deer can be a hazard.

Approximately 13km from CHESHUNT you will cross Corr Creek (signposted) and immediately after the creek crossing, you will find the entrance gate to Typo Station on the RIGHT

### Via MANSFIELD from YARRA GLEN (MELBA HIGHWAY)

From YARRA GLEN, travel north on the **Melba Highway (B300)** toward YEA, passing through GLENBURN

At YEA, turn RIGHT into **Miller Street**

A T-intersection will appear - turn RIGHT onto the **Goulburn Valley Highway (B340)**

After approximately 20km the road briefly becomes dual carriage and is now named the **Maroondah Highway (B300)**

Travel along this road for approximately 60km to MANSFIELD, passing through YARCK, MERTON and BONNIE DOON

Travel directly through MANSFIELD and veer left onto the **Mansfield-Whitfeild Road (C521)** after passing through the township

Approximately 60km from MANSFIELD you will arrive in WHITFIELD

A T-intersection will appear approximately 600m into WHITFIELD - turn RIGHT onto the **King Valley Road** and travel this road to CHESHUNT; after this town the road becomes the **Rose River Road**

CONTINUED...

After approximately 5km the **Rose River Road** becomes unsealed - drive carefully! The road is winding and the surface may be in quite rough or loose. At night, wombats, kangaroos and deer can be a hazard.

Approximately 13km from CHESHUNT you will cross Corr Creek (signposted) and immediately after the creek crossing, you will find the entrance gate to Typo Station on the RIGHT

## **From WANGARATTA & the North East:**

Via **WANGARATTA CENTRAL:**

Turn South onto **Millard Street** (C521) from **Wangaratta Road** (C314)

**Millard Street** becomes **Murdoch Road** (C521)

After crossing the **Hume Freeway**, **Murdoch Road** becomes **Wangaratta-Whitfield Road** (C521)

Travel along this road for approximately 44km to CHESHUNT, passing through DOCKER, MOYHU, EDI, KING VALLEY & WHITFIELD (the road becomes **King Valley Road** after WHITFIELD)

Continue on this road through CHESHUNT (the road now becomes the **Rose River Road**)

After approximately 5km the **Rose River Road** becomes unsealed - drive carefully! The road is winding and the surface may be in quite rough or loose. At night, wombats, kangaroos and deer can be a hazard.

Approximately 13km from CHESHUNT you will cross Corr Creek (signposted) and immediately after the creek crossing, you will find the entrance gate to Typo Station on the RIGHT

## **From WANGARATTA & the North East:**

**From the NORTH EAST via the HUME FREEWAY:**

Travelling South on the **Hume Highway**, take the **Greta Road** exit past Wangaratta (C523)

Turn LEFT at the first X-intersection onto the **Glenrowan-Myrtleford Road** (C522)

A T-intersection will appear after approximately 9km - turn RIGHT onto the **Wangaratta-Whitfield Road** (C521)

Travel along this road for approximately 44km to CHESHUNT, passing through DOCKER, MOYHU, EDI, KING VALLEY & WHITFIELD (the road becomes **King Valley Road** after WHITFIELD)

Continue on this road through CHESHUNT (the road now becomes the **Rose River Road**)

After approximately 5km the **Rose River Road** becomes unsealed - drive carefully! The road is winding and the surface may be in quite rough or loose. At night, wombats, kangaroos and deer can be a hazard.
